



Appointment of Authorised Representative

1. How to Appoint an Authorised Representative

If you would like to appoint an authorised representative to deal with us on your behalf, please:

- a) carefully read the important information below;
- b) carefully complete the form on the next page;
- c) take it, with some proof of your identity, to a witness as indicated;
- d) sign it in the presence of a one of the following persons below
 - i. a Justice of the Peace (JP);
 - ii. an Accountant who is a member of the Australian Institute of Chartered Accountants, CPA Australia, or the National Institute of Accounts with 2 or more years of continuous membership;
 - iii. a Solicitor or Barrister;
 - iv. a Police Officer;
 - v. an agent in charge of, or a permanent employee (with 2 or more years of continuous service) of an Australia Post outlet;
 - vi. an officer with, or authorised representative of, a holder of an Australian Financial Services Licence, having 2 or more continuous years of service with one or more licensees;
 - vii. a Dentist;
 - viii. a Pharmacist;
 - ix. a Medical Practitioner; or
 - x. a Chiropractor or a Physiotherapist; and
- e) post it to us at the address above.

2. Important Information

2.1 What is an authorised representative?

An authorised representative is defined as a person who has authority to deal with us on your behalf. Authorised representatives have the ability to discuss and make changes to your account without you being present, unless you have limited the rights of the authorised representative.

2.2 Other information

We may also accept a person who holds an appropriate Power of Attorney or Guardianship Order as your authorised representative. Please forward a certified copy of the Power of Attorney or Guardianship Order together with this form (signed by the Attorney or Guardian). We may need to have the documents checked before we can accept the appointment.

To protect your privacy and security as well as to minimise the risk of fraud, our requirement is that this form be submitted via post as a signed original, witnessed by one of the persons listed in the 'How to Appoint an Authorised Representative' section of this document.
